After spending two days in Samaria, Jesus returns to Cana. Cana was the location of his first sign, and here Jesus performs His second sign. Jesus heals a child who is at the point of death. The healing occurs because of the desperate plea of the boy's father. This is a powerfully touching story. Our attention is drawn to the interaction between the nobleman and Jesus. When the nobleman comes to Jesus, what is he looking for? He comes seeking a miracle, but he finds much more.
