September 19, 2021 Habakkuk- A Faith that Shines in the Darkness Habakkuk Argues with God Habakkuk 1:12-2:1

Habakkuk continues to lodge complaints against God. His first complaint contained three accusations: God is ignoring His people, God is allowing lawlessness, and God is tolerating injustice. God's responds to Habakkuk, however, His response brings Habakkuk further bewilderment. God's plan to right the wrongs, is to use the evil and wicked Babylonians. This plan takes Habakkuk completely by surprise.

Habakkuk decides to argue with God against His plan. Habakkuk argues this plan violates God's character. Therefore, it is a fundamentally flawed plan. After his argument, Habakkuk expects God to answer him, to which Habakkuk is ready to respond with another complaint.

 - B. God's plan violates God's righteousness. (Hab. 1:14)
 - C. God's plan violates God's essence. (Hab. 1:15-17)

The Babylonians are immoral. (Hab. 1:16)

The Babylonians are unrelentingly evil. (Hab. 1:17)

- 3. Habakkuk submits to God's answer. (Hab. 2:1)
