The King, The Cross, and The Resurrection Luke 23:26-24:7

It's amazing how quickly the tide can turn. Jesus enters Jerusalem to shouts of joy and excitement. That excitement is quickly replaced. Jesus is arrested. He is bound and brought to the religious authorities. They deliver Him to Pilate. Pilate presents Jesus to the crowd. The crowd shouts, "Crucify Him!" Jesus is crucified and dies on a cross.
