May 4, 2025 Resurrection Body 1 Corinthians 15:35-49

Up until this point, Paul has not addressed the specific questions the Corinthians have about the resurrection. These questions are the basis for their disordered belief. They are struggling to understand how the dead are physically raised and what the physical resurrected body will look like. Using analogies Paul explains how the resurrection, though mysterious, is understandable and the transformative nature of our resurrected bodies.
